ACTION ITEMS:

1. Approve payment for the reconstruction of two catch basins on Ash Street.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve payment to Turner Concrete Construction in the amount of \$5,000.

2. Approve payment to Christy Construction Co. for curb and gutter replacement and street patching in connection with the Expanded Street Repair Program 2011.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve payment in the amount of \$13,076.54.

3. Approve the agreement between the City of Ottumwa and Wapsi Valley Archeology for the Historic Property Study of the Blackhawk Bridge.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the agreement and authorize the Mayor to sign.

4. Approve the bid from Norris Asphalt Paving in the amount of \$10,390 for an asphalt overlay for the basketball court at Union Park.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the bid.

5. Final payment to Pleva Mechanical for Beach Ottumwa Renovation Project.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the penalty of \$4,750.00 for late completion of the Beach Ottumwa Renovation Project and approve final payment in the amount of \$49,327.77.
